### Thinking Critically: **Criterion D**

#### In your writing:

- After analyzing the question, concept, model, etc... that was being asked or shown, did you form a clear and organized statement?
- Did you connect all the pieces of evidence back to the original statement?
- Were your connections strong enough to form a clear and detailed picture?

#### TO SUMMARIZE:

- The “parts” of the stickman are your terms and concepts from the unit or lesson -- the things you need to “prove” you understand.
- The ways in which your stickman is connected to form a clear and meaningful picture is your Critical Thinking.
